CUTTING DETAILS

It is recommended that the first cut is completed early May to avoid the need to remove cut material.

The Southern boundary of Area A is marked by a beck running the full length of the boundary and any cutting should be done to this line. Strimming must be undertaken up to all trees, overhead line support poles etc and up to underside of hedges and fences at boundaries.

All Areas to be cut once per month May to September

Area C is to be cut as an approx 3 m strip along road edges once per month May to September. Other areas in this section to be left to allow area to return to natural ground cover

CUTTING DETAILS

It is recommended that the first cut is completed early May to avoid the need to remove cut material.

Area A – Cut Bank & Verge twice a year in early May & early September

Areas B and C – Cut once per month May to September.

Strimming must be undertaken up to all trees, overhead line support poles, rocks, picnic tables etc and up to underside of hedges and fences at boundaries.

Area D – To avoid disturbance of flowering species this area is to be cut ONLY once per year at the time of the September cut.

CUTTING DETAILS

It is recommended that the first cut is completed early May to avoid the need to remove cut material.

Cut both areas once per month May to September.

KIRKBAMPTON VILLAGE GREEN (2)



This area is opposite the entrance to Solway View and extends from the existing cut area, maintained by the school, to the line where the adjacent field extends out to the pavement line.

It is recommended that the first cut is completed early May to avoid the need to remove cut material.

Area to be cut once per month May to September.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The contractor will be responsible for either mulching or removing all grass cuttings and leaving all areas tidy at the end of every visit. An early initial cut followed by regular cutting will avoid the removal of cut grass. It should be noted that several of these areas are used by local children as play areas and as such they should be cut as short as possible at each cut so that the grass does not grow to excessive lengths between cuts.
2. This is a fixed price contract and as such the Contractor must visit the sites to ascertain exact areas and borders of cutting areas. The tender price will be for the completion of cutting of all areas.
Should there be any queries the Contractor should contact the Clerk to the Parish Council prior to submitting the tender.
3. The contractor must inform the Council should they, in the course of cutting; uncover any holes or other items that may cause problems in fulfilling the works.
4. The contractor must supply all machinery and must provide evidence to the Council of adequate public liability insurance.
5. Payment will be made in two stages, unless agreed otherwise; on or around 12th July and on completion of the last cut in September.
6. Tender Forms, as enclosed in this schedule, should be fully completed and sent **by post**, (Email will not be accepted) to The Clerk, Kirkbampton Parish Council, Vermont, Kirkbampton, Carlisle, Cumbria, CA5 6HX to be received no later than **5pm on Monday 27th February, 2012**. The envelope should be clearly marked "Kirkbampton Grass Cutting".
7. The final decision will be clearly communicated to all tenderers by the middle of March 2012. The Council's policy is not necessarily to accept the lowest tender for any or all the areas. The Council's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into on the reasons why any one tender has been rejected.
